Village HeartBEAT's Competition Season Underway

The fifth year of [Village HeartBEAT's](#) (Building Education and Accountability Together) competition season is underway. This year, the program recruited a record 32 churches fielding 10-person teams.

This month, the program kicks off weekly training in its Thereasea C. Elders Community Health Leadership Academy, and has partnered with the American Heart Association to present the Check Change Control Program, a community-based evidence intervention to improve blood pressure control.

Village HeartBEAT, a Mecklenburg County Public Health initiative to address risk factors associated with obesity and heart disease in the African American and Hispanic populations, is one of 50 finalists in the national [Healthiest Cities & Counties Challenge](#).
