

Rep. Adams Releases COVID-19 Report Report details actions taken by Adams' office to combat the Coronavirus

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The office of Congresswoman Alma Adams (NC-12) has spent the first half of 2020 fighting in Congress and in Charlotte for the best possible response to the economic and health crises caused by COVID-19.

Since the beginning of the crisis, **Rep. Adams' and her office** has:

- Responded to constituents with 10,363 letters;
- Held 19 virtual events and 21 virtual meetings with the Congresswoman, with **over 4,400 constituents** in attendance;
- **Introduced 5 bills** to address the COVID-19 crisis;
- Wrote and led 15 letters to the Trump Administration, congressional leaders, and state leaders on COVID-19 issues;
- Voted for and fought for the over **\$212 million** in federal funding awarded to the 12th Congressional District for COVID-19 relief efforts;
- Cosponsored 32 bills to respond to COVID-19 and restore our economy;
- Cosigned 98 Congressional letters to the Trump Administration, congressional leaders, and other officials on COVID-19 issues

"This is why we serve in Congress," said Congresswoman Adams. "My staff and I have worked tirelessly for a whole-ofgovernment response to this unprecedented crisis. Members of Team Adams in Washington and Charlotte have worked countless hours to connect constituents with the resources they need to weather the storm.
