At end end of your ballot, please vote YES ✓ for all three bonds: **\$146.2 million for streets, \$50 million for housing and \$29.8 million for neighborhoods.**

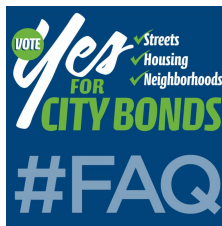


Included in the streets bond is \$10 million for projects including adding turn lanes at intersections, extending existing lanes or making connections to enhance the street grid.
