Volunteer to Become a StriveCLT Reading Tutor

We Need You!

Student enrollment is growing in our afterschool program and StriveCLT needs more tutors this school year (October 1, 2023 – May 31, 2024) to help kindergarten children who live in Southside Homes and/or attend Marie G. Davis School (near South Blvd & S. Tryon St.).

To Get Started!

Go to cmsvolunteers.com or scan the **QR code above** and register, at no cost, to volunteer for CMS. List StriveCLT as the nonprofit you will be volunteering with and Marie G. Davis as the school.

Volunteer up to 60 minutes one day each week between 4:30 – 6:00 pm!*

- **Queen City Readers (QCR) Tutor** – Tutor a Kindergarten or 1st grade child, 1:1, in synthetics phonics for 20 minutes to build decoding skills.
- **Active Reading Tutor** – Read to a group of 2-3 children at one time for 20 minutes to build vocabulary comprehension by reading with them books they select.

Volunteer Training Requirement

- **QCR Tutor:** Train for 15 minutes using 2 short videos by Read Charlotte; oversight by StriveCLT Tutor Facilitator. Requires Tutor to be a high school graduate and proficient English speaker.
- **Active Reading Tutor:** Take 60 minutes online training through Charlotte-Mecklenburg Library for Active Reading. Print and submit certificate of completion for validation. Requires Tutor to be a proficient English speaker.
