United Neighborhoods Future Grant Making

- Conduct assets and needs assessment on staggered, three year rotation
 - Affirm/amend community priorities
 - 2026: Renaissance West, Grier Heights, and Lakeview
 - 2027: Sugar Creek/85, Beatties Ford/Rozzelles Ferry, North Meck, and Freedom/Wilkinson
 - 2028: West Boulevard, Albemarle/Central, and Graham/ North Tryon
- Following assessment, engage in full grant-making process
 - Letters of interest, agency fairs, panel deliberations

- Application closes July 26, 2024
- . Awards announced December 2024
- . Grant cycle January 2024-December 2024
- Grants open to any grassroots nonprofit founded and led by a person of color
