

#### "An Informed Society is a Free Society"

What is the reasoning behind making education available to all? First, since public education is free, of cost, it is a great equalizer, giving all children the ability to reach their potential

regardless of social class. When schools charge tuition, those who cannot pay are often left out of the equation which is social mobility.

Public education also unites rural and urban areas through equal opportunity. It equalizes the life chances of the poor alongside those born into relative wealth. Public schools also serve a political role of primarily indoctrinating children into society. While "indoctrination" can have a negative connotation, it simply means introducing the morals, norms, and ideas that are predominant in a given society. While, indoctrination can be misused, educating children about society, generally speaking, may, in fact, be a positive thing.

Education also prepares children for participation in civic life. According to the Center on Education Policy, "The Founding

Fathers maintained that the success of the fragile American democracy would depend on the competency of its citizens. They believed strongly that preserving democracy would require an educated population that could understand political and social issues

and would participate in civic life, vote wisely, protect their rights and freedoms, and resist tyrants and demagogues."

So, education generally prepares students with the critical thinking skills to become successful members of society in various ways. Additionally, literacy readily prepares one for society and makes one a more productive societal member. Higher productivity is believed to lead to higher standards of living and higher life chances.

Public education, or education for all, also serves to socialize children. It provides a basis for forming friendships and social bonds. For example, segregationists knew that segregated schools would lead to segregated neighborhoods and also segregated cultures. Since education was known to be an equalizer, providing African Americans with a poor education, was also known to perpetuate social inequalities. The perpetuation of educational inequalities led to socioeconomic injustices and the continuation of systems of racial hierarchy.



Education is important in combating rigid and bigoted actions. When open to various ideologies, as exemplified through exposure through education, children are less likely to grow into adults who form in-groups and outgroups based on arbitrary distinctions.

According to the Corsicana Daily Sun,

"Public schools bring together students from diverse backgrounds, fostering social cohesion and understanding among individuals." It is well understood that people who live together form friendships and bonds. People who are apart tend not to create those same friendships and bonds.

When we invest in education, we invest in the future. If the goal is to create a prosperous, cohesive society, equipping children with the tools to create one is paramount. A functioning society is full of role models who exemplify the type of behavior that children need to emulate. If society is full of rigid thinking and hierarchy, then children will internalize that. If it is full of diverse ideas, and critical thinking, then children will emulate that as well.



And, it should be continually emphasized that the empathy children need to have for one another is enhanced by their ability to connect.

These social connections are often made through school. If we are to avoid dystopia, we need to preserve public education, not only to preserve democracy and equality but also to encourage the type of achievements that make for a prosperous, cohesive society.
