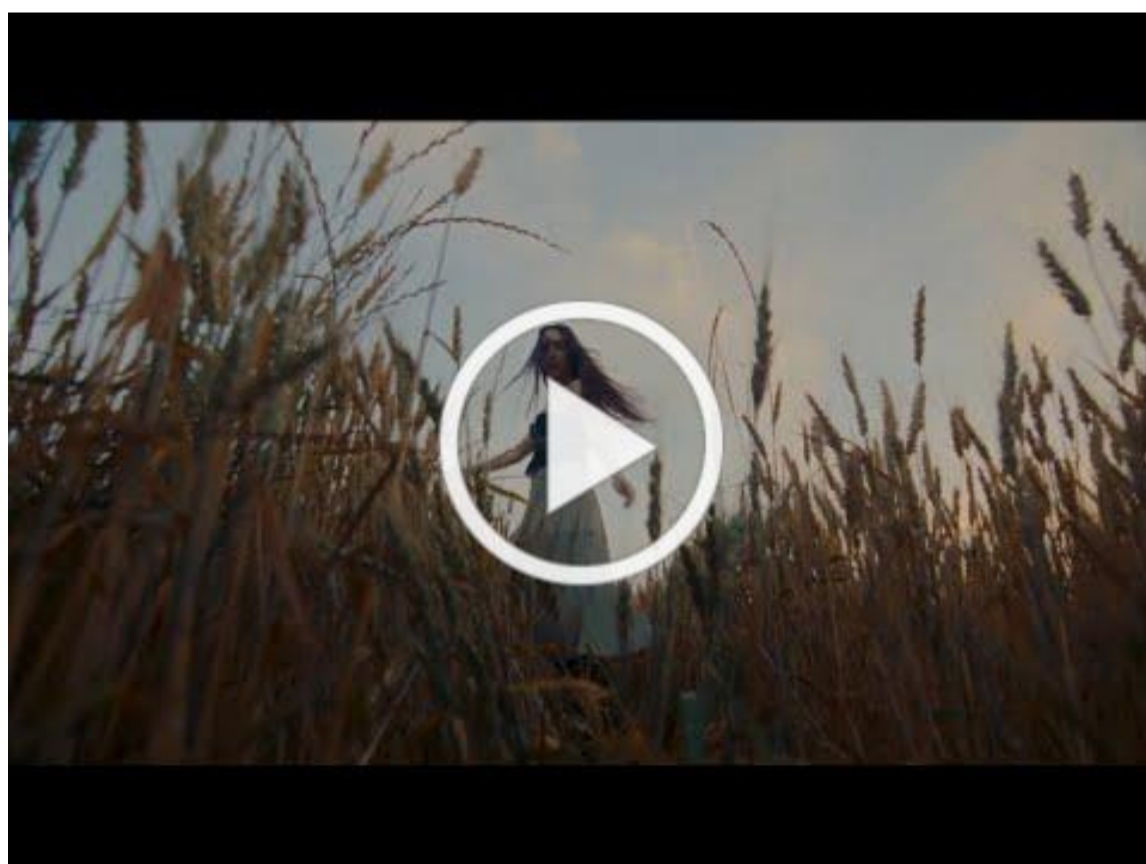

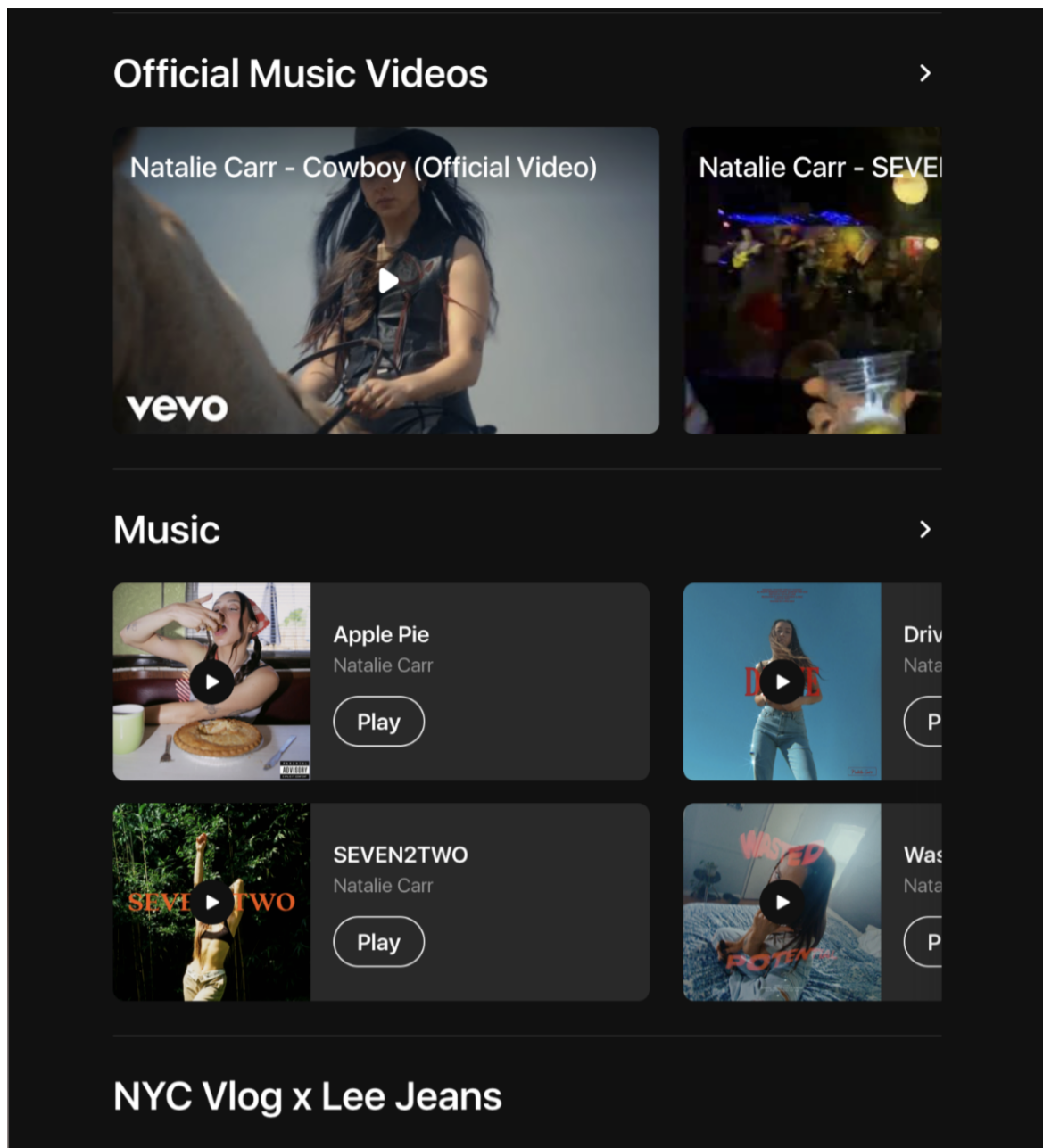
Natalie Carr – Cowboy (Official Video)

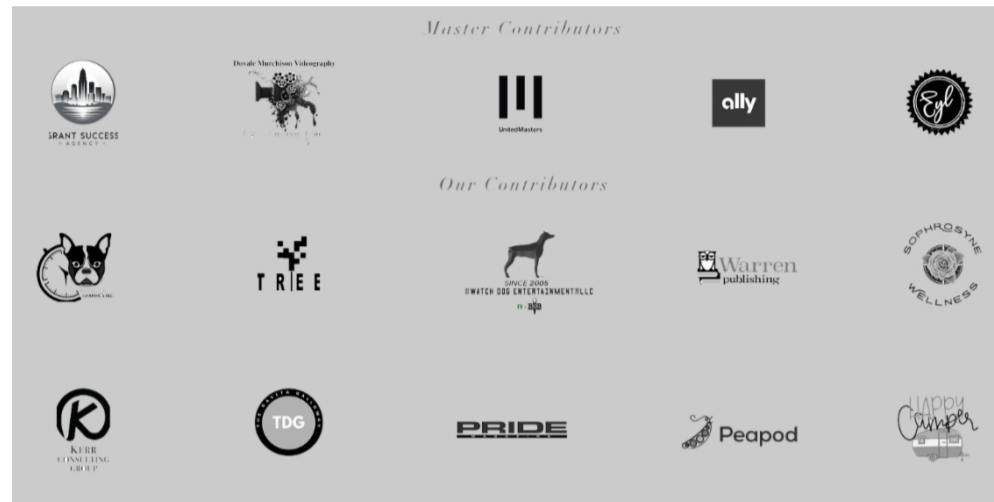
