## Clerk's Office Seeks Volunteers to Serve on Nursing Home and Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committees

The Nursing Home Advisory Committee is charged with promoting and protecting the rights of residents living in adult care homes and nursing facilities through regular visitation to long-term care facilities in the county. The Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee promotes the interests and well-being of the residents in adult care homes and only requires members to commit an average of eight hours a month.

## Chairman Dunlap Elected to Serve as Second Vice President of National Association of Counties (NACo)

During the National Association of Counties' (NACo) annual conference in Tampa, Florida, Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners Chair George Dunlap received 1,658 votes (67%) to serve as the Association's next Second Vice President. Chairman Dunlap will join NACo President James Gore of California, NACo First Vice President Judge J.D Clark of Texas, along with NACo Immediate Past President Mary Jo McGuire of Minnesota, in leading the over 40,000-member organization for the next year.

Founded in 1935, NACo is responsible for advancing excellence in public service to help people and places thrive across America. The organization is comprised of over 3,069 County governments, working with 3.6 million county employees.
